The people of York County deserve a working county government that meets their everyday needs: Sheriff's patrols that keep us safe, a District Attorney's office with the tools to help crime victims and prosecute those who are charged with crimes, and functioning Probate and Deeds offices so we can all do our daily business in York County.

Yet on September 14, York County became a less safe place to live and a more difficult place for people to get work done. That's when the county's management laid off 24 county workers, decimating these and other services people expect their county to provide. The result: **fewer sheriff's patrols, closures in the district attorney's offices, resulting in both victims and defendants not getting the information they need. People seeking vital records from Deeds and Probate can now expect delays lasting weeks in getting or filing the information they need.**

This is all inexcusable. Please call the County Manager and the three County Commissioners who ordered the service cuts right away. **Tell them to get York County working again:**
